Security Analyst	Monitors network traffic and identifies suspicious activities
Cybersecurity Analyst I	Entry-level technical and analytical support role
IT Security Analyst (Tier 1)	First responder to alerts from firewalls, IPS/IDS, SIEM
Security Operations Analyst	Frontline defender monitoring alerts and investigating threats

Junior Security Engineer	Entry point to security engineering pathway
Security Engineer	Implements security controls and solutions
Systems Administrator (Security Focus)	System administration with security responsibilities
Junior Cybersecurity Engineer	Entry-level engineering role
Associate Security Consultant	Consulting role building architecture skills

Note on Career Pathway: Security Architect roles typically require progression through mid-level positions like Security Engineer, Systems Architect, or Cybersecurity Consultant before transitioning to architecture responsibilities.

AI Cybersecurity Associate	Entry point for AI-focused security careers

Note: OT/ICS security roles are typically not entry-level and often require prior network security or industrial experience. Entry pathways include:

Job Title	Description
OT Cybersecurity Analyst (Entry Level)	Entry point for operational technology security
OT Cyber Security Technician	Junior-level position for OT security integration
Junior ICS Security Analyst	Entry-level industrial control systems security
SCADA Security Analyst (Junior)	Focuses on SCADA system security
Controls Engineer (Security Focus)	Engineering role with OT security responsibilities
Network Security Analyst (OT/Industrial)	Network security with OT/industrial focus
Critical Infrastructure Security Analyst	Protects essential national infrastructure
Associate OT Cybersecurity Specialist	Entry-level OT security specialist role

Common Pathway: Many professionals enter CNI/OT security after gaining experience in network security, IT security analysis, or industrial engineering, then specialising through certifications like GICSP (Global Industrial Cyber Security Professional).
